Year 1 trip to British Wildlife Centre

Dear Parent/Carer,

On Tuesday 27th February, Year 1 will be visiting the British Wildlife Centre. This links to our learning theme next half term; 'Fur, Feet and Feathers' where the children learn about animal classification and grouping.

Due to the increased cost of coach hire, we are asking parents to drop off and collect from the wildlife centre to reduce costs and make this trip possible. We are asking that children are dropped off at the main entrance by 9:30am. Children will need to be collected by 2:30pm from the same main entrance.

The address is Eastbourne Road (A22), Newchapel, Lingfield, Surrey RH7 6LF.

If you are car sharing for drop off/collection, please let me know directly, ahead of time, so I can update my records. We will not be able to release a child to anybody other than the parent unless we know ahead of time. (This is to safeguard all children).

Your child will need to be in full school uniform and have an appropriate coat for the weather and a water bottle. As your child gets Universal School Meals, lunch will be provided by the school.

The cost of the trip is £11.50 per child. Payment and consent can be made via Parentmail. This needs to be <u>completed by Monday 5th February</u>.

Please note that if we do not get enough contributions, we would be unable to take the children on this trip. We are sure you will agree that this will be a very worthwhile trip to support the children's learning.

We require 3 parent helpers to support us on this trip for the full day. If you are interested and available, please speak to me directly.
