This will allow us to improve the book section when learning to read through phonics. banded books for guided reading and high quality class texts to improve access to a range of genre. We will also be looking at our curriculum to supplement our non-fiction library, so that children have access to reference books that support the context in which they are learning.

FOTO are also giving us £5000 to buy a new visual and sound system for the hall - this will improve our ability to deliver high quality worship, productions and presentations. This will hopefully be installed during the summer holiday.

This year the fair raised over £5000 - we are just waiting for the last sponsorships to come in before revealing the final total!
